- 2. DOT Drug Test Results (negative esults)
- 3. Current/Valid Alabama Driver License
- 4. MVR Report
- 5. Be at least 18 years of age
- 6. Learner's Permit Training available through Adult Education
- 7. TAT (Truckers Against Traffickin g) Certificate through Adult Education

Note: All items must be completed and turned in one week prior the ft day of class.

Drug Screen result MVR report must be dated within 30 days of the start of class. All students are subject to random alcohol & drug screening durthe course of the weeks.
